Resolution #2019-01 Construction Evaluation Resolution

WHEREAS, Iowa Code section 459.304(3) sets out the procedure if a board of supervisors wishes to adopt a "construction evaluation resolution" relating to the construction of a confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHERAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution can submit to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) an adopted recommendation to approve or disapprove a construction permit application regarding a proposed confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution and submitted an adopted recommendation may contest the DNR's decision regarding a specific application; and

WHEREAS, by adopting a construction evaluation resolution the board of supervisors agrees to evaluate every construction permit application for a proposed confinement feeding operation structure received by the board of supervisors between February 1, 2019 and January 31, 2020 and submit an adopted recommendation regarding that application to the DNR; and

WHEREAS, the board of supervisors must conduct an evaluation of every construction permit application using the master matrix created in Iowa Code section 459.305, but the board's recommendation to the DNR may be based on the final score on the master matrix or may be based on reasons other than the final score on the master matrix.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EMMET COUNTY that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this construction evaluation resolution pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3).

Barb Bohm, Emmet County Assessor, came before the Board to present the proposed increase for Eagle View/Pictometry's second flight. The total proposed cost for the second flight is \$95,226.00, which is an increase of \$4,494.00 from the current contract, divided by 3 years, would be a yearly increase of \$1,498. Bohm stated that by doing this, it will give us better coverage and pixels in the rural areas. The Board of Supervisors' share is 16% of the costs. The Board's increase would be \$239.00 for the next 3 years. Their current share being \$4,744.00 adding the increase of \$239.00 for the next 3 years equaling a total of \$4,983.00. It was moved by Quastad, seconded by Hash to change the pixel resolution on the second flight and approve these proposed increases in costs. All ayes, motion carried.

It was moved by Hash, seconded by Quastad, to approve paying for the Security System for the Emmet County Courthouse out of the LOSST (Local Option Sales & Service Tax) funds for \$21,337.83 for the Security System from Midwest Technology's bid of \$19,837.83 adding an additional \$1500 for three outdoor security cameras. All ayes, motion carried.

The Board reviewed the Manure Management Plans for Owner, Daybreak Foods, Inc., Facility name. Daybreak Foods Oakridge Farm #58698; another for owner, Jay Gunderson, Facility name J & R Inc Site II #58943; and third a Nutrient Management Plan and MMP for Facility Name Olson site #67583, owner Eric Olson.

The Board also reviewed two letters from the DNR for Authorization to use for the Jack Creek 26 Site, Facility ID #70408 and the Denmark 32 Site, Facility ID #70337.

It was moved by Quastad, seconded by Hash to have the Board Chair sign two joint drainage claims for Emmet/Kossuth #EK4 for Line 22 repair for \$391.00, paid to Anderson Tiling and a claim for EK4 Line 21 repair for \$150.00 paid to Anderson Tiling. All ayes, motion carried. The joint claims have been sent to Kossuth for signage. These bills were erroneously paid by Emmet County and were now forwarded on to control county Kossuth for reimbursement back to Emmet County.
