- 4. Acceptance of the tile line shall not extend east beyond the line between the SW1/4 and the SE1/4 of Section 19, Twelve Mile Lake Township. Control and maintenance to the east of said line shall be by New Fashion Pork d.b.a. BWT Holdings, LLLP
